Federal funds are provided to County Family and Children First Councils administrative agents to be used in conjunction with state, local and other federal funds to implement and maintain a coordinated, community-based infrastructure that promotes trans-disciplinary, family-centered services for expectant parents, newborns, infants and toddlers and their families.

The county Help Me Grow programs provide outreach and child find activities; intake; and procedural safeguards, prenatal and newborn visits, home visiting services, Service Coordination; Individualized Family Service Plans (IFSP); developmental evaluations and assessments of infants and toddlers with developmental delays or disabilities.

REMARKS:

The Governor appointed Help Me Grow Advisory Council sent recommendations to ODH on changes to the SFY 2008 funding formula in Fall 2006 which were accepted. The SFY08 HMG formula builds upon the changes implemented with the SFY07 formula. More specifically, the SFY08 formula places greater emphasis on accountability and performance through the introduction of two new incentive factors, 45 Day Compliance and Transition Compliance. The formula also continues the trend of making the HMG funding allocation more equitable by increasing the percentage of funds allocated based on population (i.e., increases in the target population factor and children in poverty factor) at the same time reducing the amount dependent on historical funding (i.e., decrease in Stability Factor). The Help Me Grow program received an increase in funding for SFY '08-'09 when state budget was passed in June 2007. In spite of a net increase in total HMG funds available, the changes in the FY2008 formula will result in 17 counties receiving less funding than they received in FY2007. The decreases range from minus 0.32% (-0.32%) to minus 12.63% (-12.63) with an average decrease of minus 4.39% (-4.39%). The range of increases for the other 71 counties is between 0.00% to 34.76% with an average increase of 8.59%. One county (Ashland) applied for their entire HMG allocation, which includes TANF and GRF. Their allocation was decreased to reflect only the Part C allocation.
