Additionally training and exercise opportunities participation and/or other costs associated with emergency preparedness and response; funding agency level and regional activities in support of overall regional emergency response and preparedness activities

Applications will be judged according to the extent to which the proposal: Contributes to the advancement and/or improvement of the health of Ohioans; Is responsive to policy concerns and program objectives of the initiative/program/ activity for which grant dollars are being made available; Is well executed and is capable of attaining program objectives; Describe specific objectives, activities, milestones and outcomes with respect to time-lines and resources; Estimates reasonable cost to the Ohio Department of Health, considering the anticipated results; Demonstrates that program personnel are well qualified by training and/or experience for their roles in the program and the applicant organization has adequate facilities and personnel; Provides an evaluation plan, including a design for determining program success; Is responsive to the special concerns and program priorities specified in the request for proposal; and, Has demonstrated acceptable past performance.
