





**OVERALL ACTIVITIES COVERED BY FUNDS SOURCE:**

The Safety Net Dental Care Program is to provide access to comprehensive dental care services for a significant number of Ohioans who cannot afford and would not otherwise receive dental care (by offsetting costs of uncompensated care) and to reduce disparities in access to dental care. The Safety Net Dental Care Program is designed to provide comprehensive care through safety net dental clinics, school-based dental care and mobile/portable dental care programs. Funds may be requested to help support the cost of clinic operations (personnel, supplies, etc.). Grant funds are intended to leverage other program resources to provide services.

**REVIEW CRITERIA USED FOR SELECTION:**

1. Program must provide comprehensive dental care services for a significant number of patients who are unable to afford private dental care.
2. Clinical dental care is regularly available at least 36 hours per week, resulting in approximately 2,500 patient visits per full-time dentist and 1,300 patient visits per full-time dental hygienist per year.
3. The program must assess the individual caries risk of all clients and provide preventive services consistent with their risk level and published guidelines of a reputable agency.
4. At least 50% of the patients served through this grant will receive comprehensive dental care.
5. Program must assure that no one is denied care based on inability to pay.
