**OVERALL ACTIVITIES COVERED BY FUNDS SOURCE:**

The Second Chance Trust Fund (SCTF) works to help solve the critical shortage of organ, eye and tissue donors through education and awareness efforts. The fund is supported by a voluntary \$1 donation made when a person obtains or renews an Ohio driver's license or state identification card from the Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV). This voluntary contribution supports donation education efforts in the State of Ohio to reach students, medical professionals and the general public. The purpose is to identify and address those project(s) that focus(es) on supporting organ, eye and tissue donation in Ohio and satisfy one or more of the following:

1. Development and implementation of public education programs which may include workplace partnerships and initiatives about anatomical donation, resulting in a decrease in the number of Ohio citizens who are undecided about anatomical donations.
2. Development and implementation of public education programs designed to reach minority populations across the state, including African Americans, Hispanics, and Asians.
3. Development and implementation of campaigns that explain and promote the Ohio Donor Registry statewide.
4. Development and implementation of campaigns that explain and promote anatomical donation and the Second Chance Trust Fund to residents statewide.
5. Development and implementation of programs to recognize and honor donor families.
