**OVERALL ACTIVITIES COVERED BY FUNDS SOURCE:**

As per Section 206.42 of AM. Sub. HB66 (126th General Assembly) and OAC rule 3701-68-01 (Women's' Health Services Program), services are to include and are limited to : pelvic exams, and lab testing; breast exams and patient education on breast cancer; screening for cervical cancer; screening and treatment for Sexually Transmitted Diseases and HIV screening; voluntary choice of contraception, including abstinence and natural family planning; patient education and pre-pregnancy counseling on the dangers of smoking, alcohol and drug use during pregnancy; education on sexual coercion and violence in relationships; and prenatal care or referral for prenatal care.

**REVIEW CRITERIA USED FOR SELECTION:**

Each application for this continuation cycle was reviewed and scored by Family Planning staff for the completeness and for responsiveness to the RFP. The Family Planning team met to discuss each application, including past performance and data analysis of services, the application score and to decide on language for placing special conditions on the applications. The review also allowed program to note funding needs and technical assistance required during the FY08 cycle. Approved agencies were funded until the funds were exhausted.

**REMARKS:**

All applicants but two were funded at the level that they received in WH08. The following subgrantees will receive an increase in their award: Public Health of Dayton-Montgomery County will receive \$93,500 + \$20,300 = \$113,800. This agency has consistently served over 85% clients at or below 100% of the Federal Poverty Level, increasing their client load each year of the project. This project has been collaborating with ODH, AMCHP and CityMatCH to establish a teen pregnancy prevention program in their Adolescent Wellness Center, a facility housed in the YMCA in Dayton that serves a primarily African-American adolescents population. The program has been selected and a program plan established. The addition funding of \$20,300 will enable the agency to fund personnel to implement the program in this high need area. Outcome data will be provided to ODH at 6 months and 12 months of funding. Fulton County Health Department will receive \$43,200 + \$10,000 = \$53,200. This agency is operating past their capacity to provide services. The county is limited in clinicians willing to serve under/uninsured clients, especially those who have incomes at or below 100% of the Federal Poverty Level and who have no resources to purchase contraception. The health department will be able to serve +/- 100 additional clients with this additional funding.
