**OVERALL ACTIVITIES COVERED BY FUNDS SOURCE:**

The Creating Healthy Communities Program (CHCP) goal is to improve the health of Ohioans, support the PHHS Block Grant at the community level, and to ultimately reduce the premature mortality from chronic diseases through expansion and implementation of comprehensive population-based program in high-need communities. Diseases of the heart, cancer, stroke, chronic lower respiratory diseases and diabetes mellitus accounted for 67 percent of residents deaths during 2005. The local counties will be utilizing evidence-based and population-based initiatives in schools, communities, worksites, and healthcare settings to achieve the goal of the CHC Program.

**REVIEW CRITERIA USED FOR SELECTION:**

Since this was a competitive Request For Proposal, there were internal and external reviewers recruited to review each application. There were a total of 41 reviewers. Seven reviewers were from the Creating Healthy Communities or Heart Disease and Stroke Program. They also served as Team Leaders and led the discussion of each grant during the Concensus meeting. The remaining 34 reviewers were staff from the BHPRR, other ODH programs and external public health partners. They each read two grants. Their scores were averaged with the team leader's score. Then additional points were awarded based on the "need" for each county as listed in Appendices 8, 9, 10, and 11 in the RFP. These Appendices ranked each county by the number and percent of deaths from chronic diseases and the number and percent of individuals below poverty level. The total scores and applications were then ranked from highest to lowest. Review criteria were listed in the RFP, page 7. A Review Criteria Checklist with the possible points for each section of the application was also provided in Appendix 3, page 34. Applicants needed to score 70 points or higher to be considered for further review.
