OVERALL ACTIVITIES COVERED BY FUNDS SOURCE:

The purpose of the Dental Sealant Program is to assist providers of public health services to develop and implement programs to improve access to dental sealants for high-risk children. Funds may be used to expand existing dental sealant programs. Schools in which 40 percent or more of the students are enrolled in the free and reduced price meal program are targeted to receive preventive dental sealants in the school setting. A dentist screens students with consent to participate and provides written instructions for which teeth to seal. A dental hygienist and dental assistant provide sealants in accordance with the dentist's written instructions.

REVIEW CRITERIA USED FOR SELECTION:

1. The program must serve the target population--children at high risk for dental disease due to financial and accessibility barriers and/or past disease patterns.
2. The program has a well-developed, reasonable and efficient plan for accomplishing objectives.
3. The budget is appropriate for completing the proposed plan.
4. The cost per child for dental screenings and for students to receive dental sealants is reasonable.
