REMARKS:

The PN10 grant award shows a reduction of \$180,000 from PN09. The reduction is based on two factors: 1.) \$120,000 of PN09 was a one-time award to subgrantees for Neonatal Transformation activities and was not part of the PN10 award offering (six subgrantees @ \$20,000 each); 2.) PN10 received a \$60,000 reduction (six subgrantees @ \$10,000 each) because available MCHBG dollars to BCFHS was less in FFY10. All funding for PN10 is from the MCHBG.
