**REMARKS:**  
Additional H1N1 Supplemental (PHER) Dollars: The purpose of the PHER dollars is to support and enhance local public health infrastructure that is critical to public health preparedness and response, such as strengthening and sustaining the public health workforce; strengthening disease surveillance activities; planning and implementing possible large scale mass vaccination activities; developing effective public and risk communication guidance; developing effective community mitigation guidance; purchasing and procuring personal protective equipment, antivirals, and other pandemic related purchases for protecting the public health workforce; training and education of the public health workforce; community and personal preparedness activities; and addressing gaps and other public health challenges related to public health preparedness and response to an influenza pandemic.
