OVERALL ACTIVITIES COVERED BY FUNDS SOURCE:

Provide access to comprehensive and emergency dental care services for a significant number of Ohioans who cannot afford and would not otherwise receive dental care (by offsetting a portion of the costs of uncompensated care) and to reduce disparities in access to dental care. Funds are to be used to assist agencies that are challenged in meeting operating expenses as a result of seeing uninsured/underinsured patients.

REVIEW CRITERIA USED FOR SELECTION:

1. Program provides comprehensive and emergency dental care services for a significant number of patients who are uninsured or covered by Medicaid or a Medicaid-contracting managed care plan and who are unable to afford private dental care.
2. Clinical dental care is regularly available at least 36 hours per week, resulting in approximately 2,500 patient visits per full-time dentist and 1,300 patient visits per dental hygienist per year.
3. The program must assess the individual caries risk of all clients and provide preventive services consistent with that risk level and published guidelines of a reputable agency.
4. Accurate information about sources of revenue and expenses must be reflected, and efficient clinic operation must be demonstrated by reasonable and measurable key indicators.
5. Program must assure that no one is denied care based on inability to pay.
