**OVERALL ACTIVITIES COVERED BY FUNDS SOURCE:**

The purpose of the Save Our Sight Children's Vision Health and Safety Education Program is to ensure that children in Ohio have good vision and healthy eyes by providing vision health and safety programs and materials for classrooms. The Save Our Sight Fund is earmarked to educate children, parents and school personnel about the benefits of early screening and regular eye exams and how to keep eyes healthy and free from injury. Applicants for the Save our Sight Children's Vision Health and Safety Education Program may apply to provide vision health and safety programs for classrooms. Priority will be given to program plans with classroom-based activities, pre-K through 12th grade.
