


Homicide Deaths in Adolescents

Data Messages


Two-Year Death Rates from Homicides in 10 to 19 Year-Olds, Ohio, 2007 - 2008

- ◆ In Ohio, the two-year death rate for homicides among 10 to 19 year olds was 4.4 per 100,000.
- ◆ The Southwest region of Ohio had the highest homicide rate of 6.3 per 100,000.
- ◆ Male adolescents had homicide rate over six times higher than the rate for female adolescents.
- ◆ Black adolescents had almost 25 times the death rate from homicides than white adolescents.
- ◆ Healthy People 2010 Objective 15.32 is “Reduce homicides,” with a goal of 3.0 per 100,000.
