Instructions	<p>To register via TRAIN:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Go to https://oh.train.org or http://www.train.org and search for Course ID 10240632. Click on the Course Name3. Click on the Registration Tab4. Follow the prompts to the Course Content (You will be re-directed to the LCMS) <p>Note: If you do not have a TRAIN user account (user accounts are free):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Click the Create Account button on the left menu.2. Fill in the required fields as instructed, and then click Submit.3. Record your username and password for future reference.4. TRAIN maintains a transcript of ALL course registrations and completions, not just those courses taken through the Center for Public Health Practice <p>To register directly via the LCMS:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Go to https://www.cphplearn.org2. Enter your username and password and select Go.3. Select the Course Catalog tab4. Select Evidence Based Public Health Practice from menu at left5. Select View Evidence Based Public Health Practice Self-Instructional Modules6. Click Register via the LMS7. To add your registration to your TRAIN transcript, click on Register via TRAIN <p>Note: <i>If this is your first time on the LCMS, you will need to create a username and password. Click on Create Account as part of step #2 to establish a username and password and user profile.</i></p>
