



## **RADON INFORMATION NOTICE – RN2012.01**

To: All Ohio Radon Licensees  
Subject: NEW RADON RULES GO INTO EFFECT ON JANUARY 1, 2013

---

Please be informed that the Ohio Department of Health has recently completed a nearly 2 year long process of seeking legislative approval for revisions to Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 3701-69, (The Radon Rules).

### **The new rules are effective January 1, 2013**

The rules were revised to:

- Incorporate specific language from previously referenced USEPA protocol documents;
- Create license type specific rules that are easier to understand and comply with;
- Strengthen the requirements for Radon Mitigation System installations to increase the likelihood for long term, sustainable risk reduction from the health effects of indoor radon on Ohioans.

In addition, ODH Radon Program staff is planning to conduct an information session on the new rules and the new radon licensing system later this fall. Those attending the training will receive Radon CE's. Details will be emailed to all active licensees once plans are finalized.
