2. Public Hearings
  - a. Public hearing concerning Council's proposal to adopt new and rescind current Ohio Administrative Code rule 3701-3-11. This rule pertains to requirements related to human immunodeficiency virus testing.
  - b. Public hearing concerning Council's proposal to amend Ohio Administrative Code rules 3701:1-38-01, -12, and -13. These rules pertain to general radiation protection standards for sources of radiation.
  - c. Public hearing concerning Council's proposal to amend Ohio Administrative Code rules 3701:1-40-01, -02, -04, -06, -07, -11 to -16, -19, -20, -22 to -28, -32, and -38; to file new rule 3701:1-40-39; and to propose new and rescind current rule 3701:1-40-03. These rules pertain to radiation protection requirements.
  - d. Public hearing concerning Council's proposal to amend Ohio Administrative Code rules 3701:1-46-02, -05, -08, -11, -37 to -39, -42, -43, and -46; and to file new rule 3701:1-46-51. These rules pertain to radiation control general licenses and licenses for manufacturing and distribution.

Public hearing concerning Council's proposal to amend Ohio Administrative Code rules proposing to amend Ohio Administrative Code rules 3701:1-58-04, -06, -07, -10, -11, -15, -24 -25, -27, -32, -34, -37, -48, -57, -60 to -63, -68, -69, -74, -79, -82, -92, -94, -101 to -103; and to rescind current and file new rules 3701:1-58-21, -35. These rules pertain to medical uses of radioactive materials.
3. Council will consider approving the minutes of the June 10, 2010 regular PHC meeting.
4. Unfinished Business
  - a. Council will consider amending Ohio Administrative Code rules 3701-20-01 to -05, -07, -08, -10, -11, -13 to -20, -22, and -24 to -26; and rescinding rule 3701-20-06. These rules pertain to the licensing of adult care facilities.
  - b. Council will consider amending Ohio Administrative Code rules 3701-34-02 to -04,

-06 to -08, and -10. These rules pertain to asbestos hazard abatement contractors, specialists, and other professionals.

- c. Council will consider amending Ohio Administrative Code rule 3701-43-09. This rule pertains to the criteria and procedures for payment of Bureau of Children with Medical Handicaps providers.

5. New Business

- a. Council will consider proposing to amend Ohio Administrative Code rule 3701-5-03; and to file rule 3701-5-14 without change. These vital statistics rules are being considered due to five-year review.
- b. Council will consider proposing Ohio Administrative Code rules 3701-43-16, -16.1, and -16.2 without change. These rules pertain to the Bureau of Children with Medical Handicaps; they are being considered due to five-year review.
- c. Council will consider proposing to amend Ohio Administrative Code rules 3701:1-44-05 and -15; and to file rules 3701:1-44-01 to -04, -06 to -14, and -16 to -25 without change. These rules pertain to the licensing of source material. They are being considered pursuant to five-year review.
- d. Council will consider proposing to amend Ohio Administrative Code rules 3701:1-54-01, -07, -09, -10, and -12, and to file rules 3701:1-54-06, -08, and -11 without change. These rules pertain to low-level radioactive waste, and they are being considered pursuant to five-year review.
- e. Council will consider proposing a new Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 3701:1-67-01, comprising rules 3701:1-67-01 to -09, and -12. These rules pertain to radiation-generating equipment therapy. Council will also consider rescinding rules 3701:1-66-14 and -15, the text of which will be moved to the new chapter.
