


DRUGS: Inhalent use

Q55: During your life, how many times have you sniffed glue, breathed the contents of aerosol spray cans or inhaled any paints or sprays to get high?

In 2005, most students reported that they did not use inhalants.

- 11.9 percent of students reported sniffing glue, breathing the contents of aerosol spray cans or inhaling any paints or sprays to get high one or more times during their life.
- There were no significant differences in having ever used inhalants by gender or grade level.

Overall, significantly fewer students reported ever using inhalants in 2005 (11.9 percent) than in 1999 (17 percent).

- This difference was also significant for males and students in the 11th grade.
- There was no significant difference between 2003 and 2005.

*The estimate may not be reliable. Significance not assessed for this variable.
