

Q97: When was the last time you saw a doctor or health care provider for a checkup or physical exam when you were not sick or injured?

In 2005, almost two-thirds of students reported that they got a medical checkup in the past year.

- 64.3 percent of students reported seeing a doctor or health care provider during the past 12 months for a checkup or physical exam when they were not sick or injured.
- There were no significant differences in seeing a doctor or health care provider when they were not sick or injured by gender, grade level or race.

There was no significant difference overall in the percentage of students who report getting a routine medical checkup in the past year between 1999 and 2005.

- A significant decrease was observed for female students who report getting a routine medical checkup between 2003 (73.4 percent) and 2005 (64.9 percent).
