

# INJURY: Seat Belt Usage—Driver

## Q9: How often do you wear a seat belt when driving a car?

In 2005, most students reported wearing seat belts when driving a car.

- 13.6 percent of students reported never or rarely wearing a seat belt when driving a car.
- Significantly more males (19.3 percent) than females (7.2 percent) reported never or rarely wearing a seat belt when driving a car.
- There were no significant differences in seat belt usage when driving a car by grade level or race.

There was no significant difference between 2003 and 2005.

This question was not asked in 1999.

This calculation excludes those students who do not drive.

\*The estimate may not be reliable. Significance not assessed for this variable.
