

Q68: During the past three months, with how many people did you have sexual intercourse?

In 2005, approximately one-third of students reported that they have had sexual intercourse in the past three months.

- 36.4 percent of students reported having had sexual intercourse with one or more people during the past three months.
- There were no significant differences in having had sexual intercourse in the past three months between males and females.
- Students in the 10th (34.6 percent), 11th (39.7 percent) and 12th (54.9 percent) grades were significantly more likely than students in the ninth grade (18.3 percent) to have had sexual intercourse with one or more people during the past three months. Students in 12th grade were also significantly more likely than those in 10th grade to have had sexual intercourse with one or more people during the past three months.
- Black students (57.8 percent) were significantly more likely than white students (33.1 percent) to have had sexual intercourse with one or more people during the past three months.

There were no significant differences in having had sexual intercourse in the past three months between 1999 and 2005.
