

Q71: The last time you had sexual intercourse, what one method did you or your partner use to prevent pregnancy?

In 2005, approximately one-fourth of students reported using birth control pills to prevent pregnancy.

- 20 percent of students who reported having had sexual intercourse during the past three months reported that they/their partner used birth control pills during last sexual intercourse.
- There were no significant differences in the use of birth control pills by themselves/their partner to prevent pregnancy by gender, grade level or race.

There were no significant differences in birth control pill use between 1999 and 2005.
