

Q31: In an average week when you are in school, how many hours do you work at a paying job outside of your home?

In 2005, less than one-half of students reported that they have a paying job.

- 41.3 percent of students reported working one or more hours at a paying job outside of their home, during an average week when they are in school.
- Significant differences were observed between each grade level. With each subsequent grade level, students were significantly more likely to have a paying job than the previous grade level.
- There were no significant differences in students with paying jobs by gender or race.

There were no significant differences in having a job between 2003 and 2005.

This question was not asked in 1999.
