

Q33: During the past 12 months, how many times have you avoided peer pressure that could have put you at risk or in dangerous situations?

In 2005, approximately one-half of students reported that they avoided peer pressure.

- 53.5 percent of students reported that they have avoided peer pressure that would have put them at risk one or more times in the past 12 months.
- Students in the 12th grade (59.8 percent) were significantly more likely than students in the ninth grade (47.5 percent) to have avoided peer pressure in the past 12 months.

There were no significant differences in avoiding negative peer pressure by gender or race.

There were no significant differences observed between 2003 and 2005.

This question was not asked in 1999.
