Subject: Early Intervention Compliance for State Fiscal Year 2013 – Timely Receipt of Services

Date: January 18, 2013

The Bureau for Children with Developmental and Special Health Needs (BCDSHN) will begin examining Early Intervention (Part C) Compliance data in February to determine statewide and county-specific compliance. These data will be reported to the U.S. Department of Education, Office of Special Education Programming (OSEP) in upcoming reports.

ODH/BCDSHN will continue to utilize a cyclical monitoring cycle. In other words, we will review all 88 counties in all three compliance areas (i.e., Transition Planning Conferences, Timely Receipt of Services, and 45 Day) over a three-year period. **We will begin examining Timely Receipt of Services (TRS) data in February.**

Your county has not been selected to be included in the upcoming TRS analysis. Instead, your county will be included in the SFY13 Transition (Transition Planning Conferences & Steps) analysis that is scheduled to begin in August. You will receive additional information at a later date regarding the timeline for this data analysis.
