OVERALL ACTIVITIES COVERED BY FUNDS SOURCE:

Applicants are funded in one of the following three injury priority areas 1) unintentional child/youth injury prevention; 2) falls among older adults; 3) unintentional prescription drug poisoning.

Activities include multi-faceted, evidence- and community-based injury prevention programs. Programs must incorporate the following activities:

- 1) Injury surveillance and/or community needs assessment;
- 2) Education/training relative to the risks associated with injury;
- 3) Enactment and/or enforcement of policies aimed at reducing injury risks;
- 5) Design and implementation of environment and/or systems' change strategies that will reduce injury risks;
- 6) Implementation of social marketing/public information campaigns aimed at changing knowledge attitudes and behavior related to injury risks;
- 6) Evaluation of the effectiveness of measures instituted.

Programs must have one FTE devoted to injury prevention activities.

REVIEW CRITERIA USED FOR SELECTION:

- 1) Applicants successfully completed all sections and complied with program guidelines and requirements as listed in the RFP, including the inclusion of required program activities as listed above.
- 2) Applicants submitted a budget appropriate with the proposed activities.
- 3) Applicants demonstrated the ability to successfully complete the proposed project and achieve the goals and objectives as written in the application for funding.
- 4) Applicants demonstrated compliance with the requirement to devote a full-time employee to injury prevention activities.
- 5) Based on the standardized reviewer score sheet, applicants received an average minimum score of 100 out of 150 points.

Two of the approved applications (Union County, Fairfield County) were funded at reduced funding levels. Applicants had the opportunity to apply for supplemental funding to conduct statewide coalition building activities. These applicants applied but were not selected for this supplemental funding. One applicant (Delaware County) will be funded at an increased level from their request as they were selected for the supplemental activities. Their supplemental budget was included in the project narrative section of their application.

Eight applications were disapproved by the review teams and did not receive average scores in the fundable range; four were approved with multiple special conditions but were low priority for funding and there are insufficient funds for all approved applications.
