OVERALL ACTIVITIES COVERED BY FUNDS SOURCE:

The Creating Healthy Communities Program goal is to improve the health of Ohioans, support the PHHS Block Grant at the community level, and to reduce the premature mortality from chronic diseases through expansion and implementation of comprehensive population-based interventions in high-need communities. Diseases of the heart, cancer, stroke, diabetes and chronic lower respiratory diseases accounted for 67 percent of resident deaths during 2005. The local CHC counties will be utilizing evidence-based strategies to develop policies, systems, and environmental changes in schools, communities, worksites, and healthcare settings in order to achieve program goals.

REVIEW CRITERIA USED FOR SELECTION:

This was a continuation Request For Proposals for 2011 and all the current subgrantees were eligible to reapply for continuation funding. There were internal reviewers within the CHC Program and the Bureau of Health Promotion and Risk Reduction that participated in the grant review, discussion of the workplan and budget, and final awards. There were six internal reviewers. Each grant was read by two reviewers. A Review Criteria form was provided to each reviewer for making comments. Since this was a continuation RFP, scores were used to review and quantify the acceptability of each section in the applications. Adjustments were made in the total award of four counties based on the subgrantees performance in 2010, their budget and their budget justification.
