**OVERALL ACTIVITIES COVERED BY FUNDS SOURCE:**

Services include screening for breast, cervical and testicular cancer; gynecological examinations and the provision of contraception; laboratory testing (hematocrit, hemoglobin, pap smear, gonorrhea, VDRL, chlamydia culture, urine dipstick for sugar and protein; and pregnancy testing); blood pressure, height, weight and BMI measurement; thyroid, heart, lung, abdominal and extremities check; screening and treatment for sexually transmitted diseases, including HIV testing; counseling and education; patient education and information about infertility, contraception, pregnancy, sterilization, preconception care, nutrition; determination of rubella immunity status and DES exposure; counseling and education on avoiding sexual coercion; assessment, counseling and referral for avoiding high risk behaviors; referral and follow-up for other needed services; and community outreach and education.

**REVIEW CRITERIA USED FOR SELECTION:**

Each application was reviewed by program staff for required information. A review form was provided for each reviewer that allocated points, 1-5, for each section of the application (Narrative, Budget, Narrative, Information, Program Narrative, Attachments, and Past Performance). Information that was missing or deficient in the application was noted and used to apply special conditions to the Notice of Award.

REMARKS:

There were 31 subgrantee applications in FP09; there are 28 applications for FP11. 1. The Women & Family Services in Defiance County closed May, 2009 and the funding was reallocated in 2009 to the Henry County Health Department to provide services in Defiance County and to the Fulton County Health Department to provide services in Williams County. 2. Clinton Memorial Hospital closed its family planning clinic June, 2009 and the funding was reallocated in 2009 to the Highland County Community Action Organization to provide services in Clinton County. 3. The Fairfield County Combined Health District has closed its family planning clinics as of July 1, 2010 and their funding, \$66,134, has been allocated in this SAAN to Family Health Services of East Central Ohio to provide services in Fairfield County.
