OVERALL ACTIVITIES COVERED BY FUNDS SOURCE:

The Ohio Department of Health (ODH) Immunization Program seeks to maintain and coordinate a program to educate physician offices that provide immunizations to pediatric patients in order to improve the rates of vaccines administered on-time, thus lowering the occurrence of vaccine-preventable diseases among Ohio's pediatric population. This program is referred to as Maximizing Office Based Immunizations (MOBI). MOBI will equip and enable local health districts to provide at least 350 high quality peer-to-peer education programs to Ohio private practices during the grant period. MOBI activities in Ohio fulfill recommended objectives 8.3s, 8.3x, 8.3z, 8.3bb of the 2008-2012 Federal Immunization Program Operations Manual (IPOM).

The MOBI grant has 6 core objectives that will be completed by the approved grantee: 1) MOBI presentation development; 2) MOBI presentation support; 3) Training the trainers; 4) On-going design and development; 5) Marketing; and 6) Program administration and evaluation.

REVIEW CRITERIA USED FOR SELECTION:

The application was evaluated based on the Application Review Form (Appendix 3) contained in the MOBI RFP. The 2011 MOBI grant application was a competitive grant application. The Ohio Chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics was the only applicant.

The program period will be from 1/1/2011 through 12/31/2013. The budget period will be from 1/1/2011 through 12/31/2011.

The 2011 MOBI application was scored by two independent reviewers from the Immunization Program workforce. The average score was 77.1 %.
