OVERALL ACTIVITIES COVERED BY FUNDS SOURCE:

Fifty-six (56) external grant reviewers with expertise in maternal and child health and public health, as well as 14 staff from the Bureau of Child and Family Health Services reviewed 67 competitive grant applications for SFY12. The Child and Family Health Services (CFHS) program is designed as an organized community effort to improve the health status of women and children in Ohio by identifying needs and implementing programs and services to address identified needs. CFHS goals are to be accomplished by engaging in a focused, multidisciplinary, collaborative approach to health improvement in coordination with internal and external stakeholders that serve racial and ethnic groups disproportionately affected by poor health outcomes, including, but not limited to, local public health agencies, community health centers, community-based organizations, faith-based organizations, private sector organizations and other public health providers.

REVIEW CRITERIA USED FOR SELECTION:

Each competitive application was reviewed and scored (100 points possible) by two external reviewers and one reviewer from the Bureau of Child and Family Health Services. Reviewer scores were combined for a total score. In addition, BCFHS added a fourth score based on an index of need. The index criteria was based on the number and percent of low birth weight births, percent of mothers smoking, number and percent of preterm births, number of physicians in the county, number of women in the county, and ratio of providers per 1,000 women. The total point possible per application was 400.

The application review criteria was based on the content of the Executive Summary, Description of Applicant Agency, Documentation of Eligibility, Personnel, Problem/Need, (including Collaboration, Eligibility and Justification, Community Health Assessment Process, and Priority Population), the CFHS Program Plan, Cultural Competency, and the Budget Narrative (including the CFHS Budget Summary Sheet and GMIS Budget Narrative).

This SAAN contains federal and state funding. SFY12 is competitive year for CFHS: the 1st year of the CFHS grant cycle. \$8,079,899 was available for competitive grants, which is 35% less than allocations for the last competitive year (FY06). \$9,668,583 was requested by 67 subgrantees; \$8,079,899 will be distributed to approved applicants. Fifty-nine (59) CFHS competitive grant applications were reviewed & approved. Eight (8) grant applications were not funded. Joel Knepp was an additional internal reviewer.
