The Public Health Emergency Preparedness (PHEP) grant funds are to address bioterrorism, outbreaks of infectious disease, and other public health threats and emergencies at the county and regional public health level

REVIEW CRITERIA USED FOR SELECTION:
Continuation year: Only agencies currently funded under the PHEP program eligible to apply.
Public Health Emergency Preparedness (PHEP): Applicant must have a full-time administrative triad in place (full-time Health Commissioner and/or Administrator, Director of Nursing and Director of Environmental Health). For Counties where the LHDs do not meet the triad, they must work with another LHD in an adjacent county to be their administrative agent. No more than one project will be funded per county.
Regional Public Health Coordination (RPH): Applicant must be recommended by the Regional public Health Steering Committee and approved by ODH. Service area is defined as each Ohio Homeland Security Planning region.
Cities Readiness Initiative (CRI): Applicant's metropolitan area and funding levels are defined by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).
Public Health Liaison: Defined as the link between the PHEP subgrantee, Association of Ohio Health Commissioners and ODH.
