CareSource Community Models

HCAN AND CHAP

- Health Care Access Now (HCAN)
 - Independent contractor
 - Participating agencies provide data to improve neonatal outcomes, influence health care behaviors and support Ob-Gyn services
 - Pregnancy Pathway services provided by HCAN participating agencies
 - Participating agencies:
 - Healthy Moms and Babies
 - TriHealth Parish Nurse Program
 - Santa Maria Community Services
 - Hamilton County Jobs and Family Services
 - Cincinnati Health Department

Scope of work

HCAN

- **Enroll all identified pregnant women from multiple referral sources into Pregnancy Pathway**
- **Perform assessment which includes CareSource eligibility, sources of prenatal care and barriers to obtaining services**
- **Schedule appt with OB provider**
- **Confirm compliance with appt and document appt date and next scheduled appt**
- **Monitor and document appointments and assure continued access**
- **Provide prenatal education**
- **Coordinate with CareSource care manager**
- **Document delivery- gestational age, weight and date**
- **Document mothers postpartum visit and infants newborn visit and provider**

Each step is reimbursed with maximum incentive per enrollee for viable birth 2500 g or more plus administrative fee



Community Health Access Project (CHAP)

- **Pregnancy Pathway (scope of work similar to HCAN)**
- **Maximum incentive for Pregnancy Pathway: for viable infant 2500g or more plus additional \$\$ for assessment**
- **Incentive model includes added incentives for:**
 - - Family Planning
 - - Medical Home
 - - Postpartum
 - - Developmental Screen
 - - Developmental Referral
 - - Immunization screen
 - - Immunization referral
 - - Frequent ER Users and incentive for % reduction in ER
