

- All 2013 data is preliminary...but close to complete
 - We are still awaiting final out of State birth and death files from bordering States
 - Final numbers and rates are very likely to be a bit higher
- We expect 2013 data to be final by the end of the year
 - Will be presented at the 2nd Ohio Infant Mortality Summit, 12/04/2014
- Remember, these numbers and rates reflect results BEFORE...
 - Progesterone project began (OPQC)
 - OHA joined our effort
 - Ohio Institute for Equity in Birth Outcomes initiated any interventions
 - Safe Sleep campaign kicked off
 - Ohio Association of Community Health Centers joined our effort
 - Any of the recent legislative bills were passed and adopted
 - The formation of Cradle Cincinnati, the Greater Columbus Infant Mortality Task Force or several other local initiatives began
 - So...we have reason to believe that 2014 can be our BEST year EVER!!!
 - Only half of 2014 has passed...so we still have time.
- According to the CDC: Deaths, Final Data for 2011 will be released 6/6/2014
 - This is the article that allows us to rank States by IMR, Race



Ohio Births, 2000-2013*




