


Patient-Centered Medical Home (PCMH)

What's that?

A patient-centered medical home is a doctor's office or clinic where you have a team of healthcare workers who will care for all of your health needs. Not just one doctor, but a whole team. Don't get confused by the word "home." A patient-centered medical home is not like a nursing home and your care team is not going to your home.

The most important job of a medical home is to take care of you and your family. Not just your broken foot or your heart condition or your diabetes, but all of you. Your care team gets to know you and your family personally.
