Registration is open to all licensed nurses working in Ohio schools; however, priority registration will be given to Registered Nurses.

### **Registration:**

Registration will be available utilizing OhioTRAIN. To register, go to OhioTRAIN at <https://oh.train.org>

If you have not used OhioTRAIN before, go to "Create Account" on the website and follow the directions. Once you are in OhioTRAIN, enter the number **1054120** in the search box. You will see the conference title "**2015 Ohio Department of Health Regional School Nurse Conferences.**" Please click on "**Add**" button to choose your conference location (Cincinnati-Blue Ash, Newark or Sandusky).

**Registration deadline:** February 27, 2015 for Cincinnati-Blue Ash; March 13, 2015 for Newark; and April 10, 2015 for the Sandusky location, or until facility capacity is reached (whichever comes first). Registration and fees must be received by the dates listed above. A confirmation e-mail will be sent upon receipt of your payment. Due to space limitations, confirmation is necessary for you to attend the conference; no phone, fax or walk-in registrations can be accepted.
