Updates/changes will be made to ET 3.0 on February 20, 2013. When updates/changes occur, a memo is sent to county HMG contract managers and ET System Administrators. *Please notify all of your contractor ET users that this memo can be accessed under “ET Info” in Early Track.*

Summary of Updates and Changes

This release involves significant changes to all major parts of Early Track. The changes include (1) adding waitlisting to Early Track for Home Visiting contractors, (2) the collection of minutes rather than start and stop times for Home Visit components, (3) prior authorization for times that exceed billing caps for the Home Visiting program, (4) additional ways to satisfy the Early Intervention screening requirements (5) informed clinical opinion as an eligibility reason for Early Intervention, and (6) redetermination for Early Intervention.

Central Coordination/Home Visiting – Waitlisting

- If a Home Visiting contractor reaches overall capacity or capacity for the alternate criteria families, Central Coordination workers can put the family on a waitlist in Early Track. The screenshots below walk through the process of adding a family to the waitlist and taking the family off of the waitlist.
- When speaking with the primary caregiver, all Home Visiting referral questions are required so Early Track knows whether to categorize the referral as targeted or alternate.

- Since capacity is calculated at the *family* level and not the *child* level, it is very important that primary caregivers are accurately linked to children. All children linked to a particular primary caregiver constitute a family for Early Track purposes. If a sibling of a child currently referred/served by a Home Visiting contractor is referred to Home Visiting, the sibling can be assigned to the Home Visiting contractor regardless of the contractor’s capacity status since the number of families assigned to the contractor will not be changed by adding the sibling.

- Central Coordination workers will have waitlisting information for all Home Visiting contractors in their county. Highlighted contractors have no capacity for the family being referred. A negative number indicates the number of families the contractor is over capacity. In the screenshot below, no contractor has capacity for the alternate family being referred. In addition, the BEIS Home Visiting Contractor is *over* capacity by 45 families for the alternate criteria.

- Clicking on the folder to the left of the contractor will take Central Coordination workers to a screen where they can remove a child/ren from the contractor waitlist. Simply choose the child to remove from the waitlist and then click "Assign." Once the user clicks "Assign," Early Track will automatically create a Home Visiting program referral dated the day of the removal from the waitlist.

Home Visiting – Total Time Minutes Data Collection

- Effective the February release, start and stop times for certain Home Visit components will no longer be required for children who do not have a sibling being served in Home Visiting. Curriculum, Family Plan, Informal Assessment, and Tool times can be reported in total minutes spent on each component. However, if a Home Visitor is serving with two or more children in the same family, start and stop times must continue to be tracked for these particular children to ensure that the contractor is paid for all non-overlapping time. Clicking on the “Show start/end times instead of minutes” at the bottom of the Home Visit screen lets users enter start and stop times rather than total minutes.

Home Visiting – Claims Approval Changes and Prior Authorization

- The claim events approval process has changed. Individual events other than documentation, data entry, and referral follow-up times will no longer be approved separately. Instead, preparation time, travel time, parenting education time, family plan development time, tool time, and informal assessment time associated with a single Home Visit will be approved all at once.
- The Home Visit will not appear on the claims approval screen until all tools and/or family plan indicated on the Home Visit have been entered. Clicking on the folder next to a Home Visit will list all times about to be approved for payment.
- Documentation, data entry, and referral follow-up will continue to be approved separately.
- Performance enhancements have been deployed to the claims approval process to speed up the process and reduce the errors users encountered on this page.

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- Once events and Home Visits are approved, any event needing prior authorization will be listed on the “Claims Requiring Prior Authorization” tab. If an event on a Home Visit needs prior authorization for payment, payment for the entire Home Visit will be put on hold until the prior authorization component is dealt with. For example, if the 2/3/13 preparation time exceeds a cap, none of the other 2/3/13 Home Visit time will be paid until the prior authorization issue is resolved.
- Users can accept the cap maximum (the cap maximum minutes are listed next to the entered minutes column), request prior authorization, or unapprove the event so data entry errors can be fixed.

- If the user chooses to seek prior authorization, a new screen will pop up and the user will specify the length of time for which prior authorization is sought (one time prior authorization for the particular event (“only”), until a particular date in the future (“to end date”), or until the child has exited from Home Visiting (“until exit”).
- Home Visiting consultants will be reviewing prior authorization requests regularly. All prior authorization requests and approvals will be documented in Early Track.

Early Intervention – Informed Clinical Opinion (ICO)

- ICO is entered on the eligibility tab under “Evaluation.” Once an evaluation is entered with no delays present, additional questions will appear at the bottom of the screen. If the evaluator(s) indicate that the child has a delay/s, the child can be made eligible for Early Intervention via ICO.
- Two different disciplines are required, but there can be one or two evaluators.

Early Intervention – Redetermination

- Redetermination is now available in Early Track for all children. The first children affected will be those made eligible via ICO after September 3, 2012 and those children who were served in Early Intervention on September 3, 2012.
- The following screenshots walk through the redetermination process for a child who was served on September 3, 2012 and who needed her eligibility redetermined in addition to the child/family assessment and need for services.
- In this example, redetermination of the child’s eligibility is required. If redetermination of eligibility is necessary *any* eligibility reason can be used. This is entered by clicking on “New” under the “Eligibility” left menu option.
