



AFIX Data Reporting and Submission

In 2014, the CDC created the AFIX online reporting tool in order to streamline data submission and collection. The online reporting tool is located on a secure portal and thus permission will need to be granted to access the tool. In addition to reporting information into the online tool, a complete AFIX report packet will be used during the feedback session and left with the provider. Recent changes allow grantees to submit a reduced number of forms and reports to the ODH AFIX Coordinator. These will be covered in this section.

Accessing the AFIX Online Reporting Tool:

The tool is housed in the CDC's Secure Access Management Services (SAMS). Your name (first and last) and email address are submitted to the CDC to indicate who should be given access to the tool.

Various pieces of AFIX visit information will be entered into the online system:
