

## **Perinatal Hepatitis B Survey Maternity Licensure Visit**

- 1) Is every baby born receiving the HBV before discharge?
  - a. If not, what are the barriers?
- 2) What is your protocol for checking the mother's HBsAg status on admission?
  - a. Are you aware that mothers with high risk lifestyles (which includes treatment for a STI during pregnancy) should have a repeat HBsAg on admission to L&D?
- 3) What is your protocol for no prenatal care patients or no lab results recorded for the patient?
  - a. Standing orders?—what are they?
  - b. Any barriers?
- 4) For HBsAg positive or unknown status mothers, are the HBV and HBIG given within 12 hours after birth?
  - a. If not, what are the barriers?
  - b. Is the pediatrician notified that HBIG/vaccine was given?
- 5) Is the hospital report form completed & faxed to ODH?
  - a. Any problems?
- 6) What is your protocol if a baby of a HBsAg mother is discharged without receiving HBV & HBIG?
- 7) What written information is given to parents after the infant receives HBV & how is that documented?
  - a. Immunization record with date of vaccine
  - b. VIS
- 8) What educational information is given to HBsAg positive mothers regarding follow up for their babies, themselves, and family members?
  - a. High risk schedule for the baby
  - b. PVS at 1 year
  - c. Testing for household contacts, HBV if appropriate
  - d. Yearly medical follow up for the mother
