


## Ohio Department of Health School Nursing Program Electronic Resources Information

The Ohio Department of Health (ODH) School Nursing program is fortunate to be able to provide nurses working in Ohio schools with access to a number of State of Ohio electronic resources. Unfortunately, the availability of such a variety of resources can lead to confusion about the purpose and requirements of each resource. The following sections will explain the purposes of each of the electronic resources and the requirements for accessing each of them. All resources are available free of charge.

### 1. The Ohio Department of Health School Nursing program Web page

The ODH School Nursing program maintains a Web page on ODH website at [www.odh.ohio.gov/odhprograms/chss/schnurs/schnurs1.aspx](http://www.odh.ohio.gov/odhprograms/chss/schnurs/schnurs1.aspx). The School Nursing program Web page is updated regularly and contains current ODH resources and information.



In addition to the link above, other ways to easily locate this page include:


- (1) Go to the ODH website at [www.odh.ohio.gov](http://www.odh.ohio.gov) and type “school nursing” in the Search box
- (2) Go to the ODH website at [www.odh.ohio.gov](http://www.odh.ohio.gov), select “S” from the index in the blue stripe across the page, then select “School Nursing” from the list

Access to this site is available to everyone. No passwords are required and there is no need to register for access.

### 2. The Ohio Department of Health Electronic School Nurse Bulletin Board

The ODH School Nursing program’s electronic School Nurse Bulletin Board is a method used to provide timely information to nurses working in schools across the state. This is a one-way means of communication from the ODH to nurses—messages from the ODH School Nurse Bulletin Board are delivered to your e-mail Inbox. In addition, the Bulletin Board is considered by ODH to be a primary method to provide information to school nurses and school communities during emergency situations. The Bulletin Board SharePoint site contains an archive of all Bulletin Board messages that are still current. In addition, an Educational Calendar with information about upcoming educational opportunities of interest to school, public health and Head Start nurses is also available at the portal. All nurses working in Ohio schools, public health nurses, Head Start nurses and others interested in school health are encouraged to register to receive the Bulletin Board messages.

The ODH School Nurse Bulletin Board requires registration and the creation of a username and password. It is important for the user to keep track of his/her username and password in order to access the archives, some message attachments and the Educational Calendar. The portal will not allow you to create a new account if you have forgotten your old username/password. Instructions for Bulletin Board registration are found online at:

### 3. The Ohio Department of Health Immunization Registry—ImpactSIIS

The ODH maintains a statewide database called ImpactSIIS that includes immunization and some health screening records for children. The goal of ImpactSIIS is to provide accurate, up-to-date information on

immunization and vaccination so that health care providers, parents, schools and other stakeholders can achieve the highest levels of coordination and knowledge for a healthier, safer Ohio. Licensed nurses working in Ohio schools and Head Start programs can access this registry as a means of determining the immunization status of difficult-to-track students, thus avoiding unnecessary school exclusion or over-immunization.



School and Head Start access to ImpactSIIS is limited to nurses licensed by the Ohio Board of Nursing. To access the site, a district or program keymaster nurse must be identified. This keymaster nurse must complete and return required paperwork (including confidentiality agreements signed by the district superintendent and the nurse, as well as documentation of current nurse licensure) to the ODH School Nursing program. ODH will provide the keymaster nurse with a username and password—the nurse must keep track of these in order to access the information on the registry. The district keymaster nurse then collects required paperwork from other nurses working in the district or program and provides them access to the registry. Annual renewal for nurses accessing the registry is completed electronically through the ImpactSIIS program. For further details about accessing ImpactSIIS, please see the instructions found at

#### 4. OhioTRAIN

OhioTRAIN is the premier learning resource for professionals who protect the public's health. The ODH School Nursing program uses the OhioTRAIN system to provide registration for both face-to-face and online trainings. For online training, OhioTRAIN is the launch site to register and access training materials. In addition, OhioTRAIN maintains a list of all courses or trainings each learner has taken. Learners may use the OhioTRAIN record to print/reprint a CNE certificate, document the number of CNEs provided by a course and access resources related to the training.

To access OhioTRAIN, learners must register to create an account. It is important to keep track of this username and password for future use. OhioTRAIN will not permit you to create another account if you have forgotten your username/password. To create an OhioTRAIN account, go to <https://oh.train.org> and follow the instructions there. If you forget your username and/or password, click on “Forgot Login Name/Password” on the site.
