


### Distribution of Blood Lead Levels in Ohio Construction Workers Tested for Lead, 2011



Eighty-three percent of Ohio construction workers tested in 2011 had blood lead levels lower than 25 µg/dL. Eleven percent of those tested had lead levels between 25 and 39 µg/dL, while 5 percent had lead levels above 40 µg/dL.

**Please Note: Only adults residing in the state of Ohio who were 16 years of age or older at the time of the lead test were included. Individuals tested more than once per year were counted only once per year, using the highest blood lead test result of the year. Only adults for whom employer information is known are included in the statistics.**
