SUBJECT: Shot/Bead Blast Removal of ACM Mastic

In past years ODH has not required contractors operating shot/bead blasters, for the purpose of removing asbestos-containing mastic, to obtain a license or have their personnel certified. Due to recent changes in OSHA requirements mastic removal operations using shot/bead blasting equipment will be now be considered as "Asbestos Hazard Abatement Activity" as defined in Chapter 3701-34 OAC, therefore requiring ODH contractor license, employee certification and 10-day prior notification for projects to be performed.
