

Basic OASIS C2 Training

COURSE OFFERED: January 18, February 22, March 29 and April 26, 2017

These training sessions are conducted at the Ohio Department of Health (ODH), Training Room A, 35 E. Chestnut Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215. **Please bring a valid picture ID (e.g., driver's license and/or State of Ohio ID to gain entry to the 35 E. Chestnut Street building. Do NOT bring a book bag/backpack – security will have you take it back to your car.**

Registration begins at 8:00 a.m. Class Time: 8:15 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Two breaks and lunch are scheduled. Lunch will be the responsibility of the participant. There is an ATM on the premises; however, you may be charged fees for its use. The deli onsite does not accept credit cards. Parking is normally 9.00 to 12.00/day. Dress in layers.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND: This training, which focuses on a very basic explanation of OASIS C2, and is for anyone who is actively involved with the completion of the OASIS C2. Those most appropriate for this training would be individuals **newer** to home health and OASIS (Administrators, Directors of Nurses, Field Nurses, and Therapists (PT, SLP).

OVERVIEW: Participants will receive comprehensive training on the OASIS C2. They will be provided with practical knowledge that will enable them to complete the OASIS C2 as part of the comprehensive assessment in accordance with the Conditions of Participation. By the end of the session, participants will be able to describe the basics of the OASIS C2, identify "M" items with specific guidance in order to complete the OASIS C2 data items with more accuracy, and identify areas related to quality of care.

PREPARATION FOR TRAINING: In preparation for this training, please review the OASIS C2 Guidance Manual. **Please bring Chapter 3 of the OASIS C2 Guidance Manual with you to training.** It is available for download at: <https://www.cms.gov/Medicare/Quality-Initiatives-Patient-Assessment-Instruments/HomeHealthQualityInits/Downloads/OASIS-C2-Guidance-Manual-6-17-16.pdf> If you bring a tablet or computer you must have Chapter 3 saved to your device. There is no Wi-Fi or internet connection. Make sure your device is fully charged.

COST AND REGISTRATION: These training sessions are free of charge. No CE's offered for this training. ODH does not provide lunch, snacks, or beverages due to a State policy that prohibits us from doing so. Lunch, snacks and beverages are the responsibility of the participant. If you are interested in attending one of these training sessions, you will first need to create an account through EIDC on ODH's website. Make sure your password is up to date. Once you have registered online, a confirmation email will be sent to you via the email supplied on the account request.

Because of limited space, reservations are mandatory. **Reservations** are limited to two individuals per agency and **both** must be registered. No one will be admitted without prior registration. Should reservations be low, a specific training session may be cancelled. **Parking locations and hotel** information will be available on the registration page and emailed to you near the class date.
