

# **MDS 3.0 BASIC TRAINING**

**WHO SHOULD ATTEND:** This training is for Long Term Care facilities (SNF/NF) or Swing Bed hospital personnel who are **actively involved** with the completion of the Minimum Data Set (MDS) process which is primary to the Interdisciplinary Team (IDT) members, and also Directors of Nursing (DON) and Administrators. **This class is a prerequisite for the MDS 3.0 Advanced Training.**

**OVERVIEW:** Participants will receive comprehensive training on the Resident Assessment Instrument (RAI) process. They will be provided with practical knowledge that will enable them to implement the MDS 3.0 as part of the RAI and correctly code each section of the MDS 3.0 assessments.

**PREPARATION:** In preparation for the **BASIC** training, **PLEASE READ THE MDS 3.0 MANUAL.** The **MDS 3.0 User's Manual and Chapter 3** are available for download in zip files at: <http://www.cms.gov/Medicare/Quality-Initiatives-Patient-Assessment-Instruments/NursingHomeQualityInits/MDS30RAIManual.html>

**You will also need to bring an MDS 3.0 Comprehensive Item Set (NC) and a copy of the session handouts, both of which can be found on the ODH website at:** <http://www.odh.ohio.gov/odhprograms/io/mds/mds1.aspx>

**TO REGISTER:** The DON or Administrator must register you through the Enhanced Information Dissemination and Collection (EIDC) system. If the DON or Administrator is not a registered EIDC user they can register at <http://www.odh.ohio.gov/odhprograms/io/mds/mds1.aspx>. Follow the directions and they will be notified within 24 hours with a user ID and temporary Password. After receiving this information, the DON or Administrator go to DQA Event Registration at <https://odhgateway.odh.ohio.gov/eidc/ProviderAssociationList.aspx> to register you. **When registering, your personal email needs to be entered so that you can be notified of any changes that may occur with the training session.** If any registrant cannot attend, please have the DON or Administrator go back to the registration and delete your name as soon as possible.

**Because of limited space, reservations are mandatory and are usually limited to two (2) individuals per facility. A list of participants is given to ODH Security the day before training; therefore, no one will be admitted without prior registration and there can be no substitutions for someone else who has already been registered.**

Registration cut-off is the Monday before the training date.
