Governor, State Health and Emergency Management Officials to Provide Update on Swine Flu at 5:30 P.M. Today

Columbus, Ohio – Ohio Gov. Ted Strickland, Ohio Department of Health Director Dr. Alvin Jackson, Ohio Department of Public Safety Director Henry Guzman and Ohio Emergency Management Agency Executive Director Nancy Dragani will hold a news briefing at **5:30 p.m. today, Sunday, Apr. 26** to discuss the confirmed case of the swine flu in Ohio and provide updates on the state's response to the case.

The Ohio Department of Health today confirmed a case of swine flu involving a 9-year-old boy from Lorain County. The patient is considered to have a mild case of the disease and is recovering at home.
