

## MEMORANDUM

To: All Radioactive Material Medical Licensees

Date: August 2, 2013

RE: NRC Regulatory Issue Summary 2013-10

The NRC issued a Regulatory Issue Summary (RIS) 2013-10 "Permanent Implant Brachytherapy Medical Event Reporting Under 10 CFR Part 35" dated July 30, 2013. The equivalent Ohio Administrative Code requirement for medical event reporting is in OAC 3701:1-58-101.

The NRC's intent of the RIS was to (1) supply information to assist licensees in complying with the current requirements related to permanent implant brachytherapy; and (2) announce the NRC's Interim Enforcement Policy (IEP) and explain the enforcement discretion NRC will use to provide regulatory relief to licensees.

The Bureau of Radiation Protection strives to be consistent with the NRC interpretations and enforcement policies. Please review the NRC's regulatory issue summary for applicability to your individual radioactive materials programs.
