

OHIO INFORMATION NOTICE 2006-02

DECLARATION REGARDING MATERIAL ASSISTANCE OR NON-ASSISTANCE TO A TERRORIST ORGANIZATION.

TO: All affected Ohio Radioactive Material Licensees.

PURPOSE

The Ohio Department of Health, Bureau of Radiation Protection, is issuing this information notice (IN) to all affected radioactive material licensees. The requirement is to submit the declaration listed below upon applying for a new or renewal of a radioactive materials license. **The completed declaration should be sent to the Ohio Department of Health Bureau of Radiation Protection when applying for a new or renewal of a license in the following categories:**

Academic Type A Broad Scope licenses
Medical Institution Broad Scope licenses
Medical Institution licenses
Teletherapy licenses
Well Logging licenses
Manufacturing and Distribution Type A Broad Scope licenses
Industrial Radiography licenses
Irradiator licenses
Research and Development licenses
Measuring Systems - Fixed Gauge licenses

BACKGROUND

The Department of Public Safety issued emergency Administrative Code rules 4501:5-2-01 through 05, effective April 14, 2006. These rules require certain holders of state licenses to complete a "DECLARATION REGARDING MATERIAL ASSISTANCE OR NON-ASSISTANCE TO A TERRORIST ORGANIZATION" form when applying for a new license or when renewing an existing license. The licenses affected are listed in APPENDIX A to rule 4501:5-2-02 and include some radioactive materials licenses.
