Amendments to O.A.C. Rules 3701-49-01.1, 3701-55-02, and 3701-55-04. These rules from Chapters on Fees for Laboratory Services (3701-49) and Genetic, Endocrine, or Metabolic Screening of Newborn Infants (3701-55) are proposed for amendment to enact statutory changes that add screening for Krabbe disease (and the option to forgo the screening). Rule 3701-49-01.1 is amended to reflect a cost increase due to the additional screening.
