**Admission procedures and preliminary assessment - inpatient rehabilitation facilities.**

- (A) ~~The~~ Each inpatient rehabilitation facility shall develop written criteria for admission of patients to the facility that includes a description of the programs and services available at the facility.
- (B) ~~The~~ Each inpatient rehabilitation facility shall not admit a patient to the facility unless the following conditions are met:
- (1) The patient is able to tolerate a minimum of three hours of rehabilitation therapy, five days per week;
  - (2) The patient is medically stable; and
  - (3) The patient's prognosis indicates a progressively improved medical condition with the potential for increased independence.
- (C) ~~The~~ Each inpatient rehabilitation facility shall ensure that complete a written preliminary assessment of each patient is completed by an interdisciplinary team within forty-eight hours of admission. ~~An interdisciplinary team shall perform the preliminary assessment that shall include~~ includes, at ~~least a minimum,~~ the following:
- (1) An evaluation of the appropriateness of the patient's placement in relation to the services available at the particular facility; and
  - (2) Identification of the immediate needs of the patient.
